Trash & Recycling Rules (2026)

Trash Rules

Collection Days: & Times

Tuesdays. DO NOT INCLUDE RECYCLABLE ITEMS.

Trash must be outside your back gate by **6:00 a.m.**

Please place outside **no earlier than 6:00 p.m.** the night before.

However, **only homes between 9243 and 9281 Bailey Lane** will continue to use the collection point since there is currently no sidewalk running behind these properties. For those residents, the pick-up point is across from 9263 Bailey Lane. There is a green sign to indicate the collection point including days and times to place trash/recycling there.

Types of Bags:

Black, green, or white trash bags should be used for trash. Bags must be securely tied.

The use of trash cans with lids is encouraged to discourage wildlife from making a mess.

Trash cans must be brought into the enclosed patio area after the trash is collected.

Each individual can or bag must weigh less than 50 pounds and be less than 30 gallons in capacity. Additionally, each unbagged item must be less than 36" x 30" x 30", or it is a bulk item (see below). We must separate our recyclables for Wednesday pickup (below).

Bulk Items Picked:

Collection of bulk items is an arranged pick up for a prepaid extra fee and cannot be discarded with household trash. This includes trash weighing over 50 pounds and/or larger than 36" x 30" x 30", more than 30 gallons capacity. Bulk pick-ups go through HaulShare and can either be arranged at www.haulshare.co or call 703-239-8540.

HaulShare will give instructions on where to place your bulk items for pick up.

Yard Debris:

Yard debris will be picked up with your everyday trash on Tuesdays. You must use paper lawn and leaf bags for your clippings and leaves. Individual pieces of brush or clippings must be bundled together with twine and cut to the dimensions of 3 x 4 feet: two (2) bags of clippings maximum. CS Waste will **not accept** rocks, bricks, garden pots or sod.

Recycling Rules RECYCLING IS MANDATORY

Collection Day &

Recycling is collected on **Wednesdays**.

Recycling must be placed outside your back gate by 6:00 a.m. on that day.

Times:

Please place outside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the night before.

Bags Used:

Recyclables can be single streamed. Corrugated cardboard and other boxes must be flattened. White plastic bags, clear plastic bags, grocery store plastic bags or bins **with lids** can be used. If using bags, please make sure they are securely tied.

Items Accepted & Not Accepted:

Please see the next page for what **is** and **is not** accepted for recycling. Items not accepted as recycling should be placed out as trash.

Recycling

Recycling Accepted

Paper Products:

Direct mail and envelopes, newspapers, newspaper advertising inserts, magazines, catalogs, printer paper, books bound without metal, unwaxed food boxes, phone books. Separate flattened corrugated cardboard from other materials.

Recycling Not Accepted

Paper Products Not Accepted:

- * Paper or cardboard with food residue
- * Pizza boxes
- * Waxed cardboard food boxes such as milk or juice boxes
- * Books with metal fasteners
- * Binders with metal rings
- * Shredded paper

Plastics:

EMPTY AND RINSE ALL CONTAINERS

Only plastic bottles labeled with the recycling Symbol #1, #2 or #5. *Examples:* soft drink bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles.

Must be clean, rigid and dry
Pliable plastic such as salad containers are ok.
Otherwise, they are trash

Plastics Not Accepted:

- * Plastics with food residue
- * Plastic bags your newspaper comes in (take them to the grocery store)
- * Plastic beverage glasses
- * All Styrofoam including drinking cups, peanuts, and all packing material
- * Microwave containers
- * Plastic Wrap
- * Insecticide or automotive fluid bottles
- * # 3 through # 7 plastics (splinter when broken)

Glass:

Glass is no longer being accepted with the other recyclable materials. There are special purple bins at designated locations to continue to recycle glass. The closest bin is located at Providence Community Center off of Vaden Drive.

Cans:

EMPTY AND RINSE ALL CANS

Aluminum and steel food & beverage cans.

Examples: soft drink, beer, and juice cans, soup, pet food and vegetable cans.

Other Items Not Accepted:

- * Cans with food residue
- * Pots or pans
- * Aluminum furniture, siding, or fencing
- * Propane tanks
- * Appliances or used cabinets
- * Aluminum foil
- * All PAINT
